### COVID-19 Precautions

#### Updated Policy and Summary of Change of Procedures 5/18/21

- Masks, facial coverings, or shields will be optional for fully vaccinated staff, students, clients, guests, service technicians, etc.
- Proof of inoculation will not be required. It is requested that people be respectful, responsible, and cooperative.
- All persons are asked to assess their own health before arriving at the school. Do not enter the school if you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, have been in close contact with another person who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days, or if you have been tested and are awaiting results.
- Guidelines about persons exhibiting symptoms will continue to remain in place. Leave of Absences will continue to be available to students, we continue to observe the general rule that if you are sick, do not come to school.
  - Any staff, student, or client may be sent home if exhibiting the following symptoms not caused by another condition:
    - Fever over 100.0 degrees, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, recent loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea
  - A leave of absence will be made available to students who are experiencing the above symptoms, have been in close contact with another person who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days, or if you have been tested and are awaiting results. Student may return either after:
    - Completing a 10 day quarantine, or
    - Providing a Covid test with a negative result
- Temperature checks will not be required.
- Field trip activities may be resumed.
- All areas of the building are open to 100% capacity.
- In a field where sanitation/disinfection is already a priority, we remain in a state of heightened awareness.
  - Cosmetology stations, Esthetics beds, equipment, lobby chairs, and offices are to be disinfected after each use.
  - If gloves cannot be worn for a service, then hands must be washed with soap and water prior to providing the service and directly afterwards.
  - High contact areas will continue to be disinfected frequently.
  - Hand sanitizer will remain available throughout the building, and frequent use is encouraged.
